

Ewa Murawska

Prof. Ewa Murawska is a full time professor of the flute at the Ignacy Jan Paderewski Academy of Music in Poznań. In 2003 she finished with distinction Academy of Music I.J. Paderewski in Poznań. In 2005 she finished with “Premier Prix” postgraduated studies France in Paris under the patronage of Patrick Gallois. Ewa Murawska is prizewinner of several flute and chamber music competitions (Paris, Uelzen, Brescia), and a holder of international scholarships, including the artistic and science grants from the Government of Italy (2003), France (2005), Denmark (2008), G.F.P.S (Gemeinschaft für studentischen Austausch in Mittel- und Osteuropa), Polish Ministry of Culture, Polish Ministry of Research and Science (two times). She gives regularly masterclasses in Poland, Iceland, Norway and Germany; her concert’s activity includes recitals in Poland, Germany, Norway, Denmark, Greece, Belgium, France, Iceland, Bulgaria and Italy. She recorded 14 CD’s, with artists, like P.Y. Artaud (France), A. Haraldsdóttir (Iceland) and the European Flute Ensemble. She is an author of eleven books, like “Cadenzas and Ornamentation”, “The Flute in Iceland”, “Playing the Flute with Chopin, Grieg and Sveinsson”.. In 2016 she opened in the Polish-Norwegian Culture Center and Gallois Flute Studio in Poznań, where regularly international cultural events are organized. She is currently an assistant professor at the Ignacy Jan Paderewski Academy of Music in Poznań (Poland) and gives concerts, lectures and masterclasses all over the world
